We are seeking applications from people who are occupational therapists or occupational scientists to join the Board of the Research into Occupational Therapy and Occupational Science Foundation (ROTOS) in the role of Chair. People who are either experienced researchers and / or have experience with translating research into practice and / or evaluating the impact of research are welcomed to apply.

The Chair will work closely, and share leadership responsibilities, with the ROTOS Vice-Chair, Dr Margo Van Hartingsveldt, to ensure the smooth running of both meetings and business.

The ROTOS Chair also has responsibility to represent ROTOS on the Occupational Therapy Europe Foundation Board (along with the ROTOS Vice-Chair) which is an additional commitment of an online meeting approximately 8 times a year, with the possibility of a face-to-face meeting approximately once per year. Occupational Therapy Europe is a collaboration between occupational therapists in practice, education, and research to promote and develop the delivery of occupational therapy services in Europe. All business is conducted in English, so a working knowledge of spoken and written English is necessary.

All members may be asked to represent ROTOS at meetings with other organisations, or to speak on behalf of ROTOS at conferences, events, and webinars.

The work of the ROTOS Foundation is overseen by a Board comprising up to 7 members. The Board mostly meets virtually (via Teams or Zoom) and meets around 10 times a year, with the annual meeting being held each June. In addition to a defined Board role, each Board member contributes to the delivery of the ROTOS strategy (2024-2026) and action plan.
